### **Covid-19 Response**

*The WOC has taken enhanced health and safety measures for our members, guests and staff.*

*You must follow all posted instructions while visiting the WOC.*

*An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. According to the CDC there is no evidence that COVID-19 can be spread to humans through the use of pools and hot tubs. Proper operation, maintenance, and disinfection (e.g., with chlorine and bromine) of pools and hot tubs should remove or inactivate the virus that causes COVID-19.*

#### **Check-in:**

- Due to potential contact tracing members will check-in by scanning their membership cards and photo ID will be verified (based on last year's picture).
- If there is a line at check-in members need to maintain proper social distancing until it is their turn.
- Guest fees remain \$10 for all day and \$5 after 4:00 pm. Guests will need to register at the desk for the purpose of potential contact tracing. Registration cards will be available at the front desk.
- Members are asked to stay home if they are exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 or any known contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the desk and should be used by everyone upon entering the grounds.

#### **Picnic area:**

- One family unit per picnic table.
- Members are still permitted to bring coolers and food. Grills will be available however there will be no shared utensils available. Each member using the grill will need to provide their own grill brush and utensils.
- Every other picnic table has been removed from under the pavilion to allow social distancing between tables.
- A new shaded picnic area has been created under the big trees next to the bocce court.
- The self-serve ice machine will not be available. Small bags of ice will be pre-filled and available from the freezer. Members will be permitted to get their own bag of ice to fill water bottles.

#### **Snack Bar:**

- The snack bar will continue to have prepackaged items for sale.
- The snack bar will now be open all day and located at the side window of the office.
- The drinking fountain will not be available this year. The sink near the ice machine will be available to fill water bottles.

#### **Pool deck:**

- Social distancing should be followed on the pool deck. Family units may sit together. Pool chairs can be moved to any of the lawn areas in order to maintain proper social distancing. There is A LOT of lawn space to be able to social distance. The chairs on the pool deck will be first come first serve.
- Pool chairs will be cleaned at the beginning of each day.
- When a member is done with a pool chair we are asking that the chair be placed on its side to signal staff that the chair needs cleaned before it is used by another member.
- Members are permitted to bring a lounge chair for personal use. All personal use chairs must be kept in the grass.

**Swimming pool:**

- Yellow innertubes will continue to be available for member use. The constant contact with the chemically treated water will inactivate the virus that potentially causes covid-19
- Due to the porous material of pool noodles the WOC will not supply pool noodles this year.
- Members will be allowed to bring their own pool noodles for personal use. For safety reasons no personal inflatables will be permitted.
- The lap lane should be limited to 2 swimmers at a time. At no time should two swimmers pass in the lap lane.
- If necessary the pool will be divided into sections. A sign will be posted designating the preferred number of swimmers allowed in each section. Members are encouraged to make every effort to avoid overcrowding. Parents will be responsible to help their children maintain proper social distancing. The lifeguards are employed to ensure general pool safety and cannot be responsible to monitor social distancing.
- The pool will have a 15 minute adult swim once per hour without a lifeguard on duty. This will allow members who are not comfortable swimming with younger swimmers pool time.
- During the adult swim the pool ladders will be sanitized in addition to the chlorinated pool water constantly flowing on them.

**Diving Well:**

- The diving boards will remain open for 45 minutes each hour. The deep end will be closed for 15 minutes each hour when diving board handles will be sanitized in addition to the chlorinated pool water constantly on them.
- There will be no games in the deep end that involve close contact of non family members. This includes midnight and greasy watermelon.

**Locker Rooms**

- Members are encouraged to maintain social distancing in the changing area. Only 1 family unit in the changing area at a time.
- Showers will be available and will be limited to one family unit at a time.
- Surfaces such as faucets and handles will be sanitized hourly and documented on a cleaning log.
- Members are encouraged to wash hands after contact with such surfaces.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in locker rooms and pavilions.

**Lost and Found:**

- Forgotten items will be kept for 24 hours in a clear plastic bag in the office to be claimed by the owner.
- Items left at the pool CANNOT be collected and kept for an indeterminate amount of time.
- Goggles and swim toys will not be available to borrow or share.

**Other:**

- Until further guidance is available parties will not be booked during the month of June.
- The CDC recommends the use of a mask when social distancing is not possible. This will be left at the member's discretion if they want to wear a mask.
- Lifeguards will not be wearing masks because doing so would impair their ability to perform all aspects of their job.
- Signs will be posted throughout the grounds to remind members of the CDC recommendations regarding COVID-19.
- The playground will be closed until further guidance from the state is made available.
